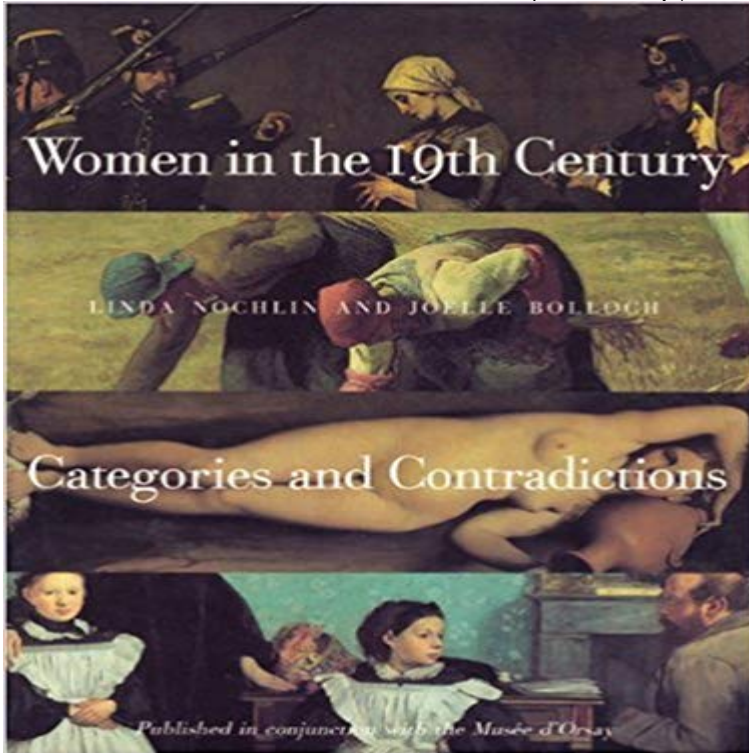


Women in the 19th Century: Categories and Contradictions (Portfolio)
