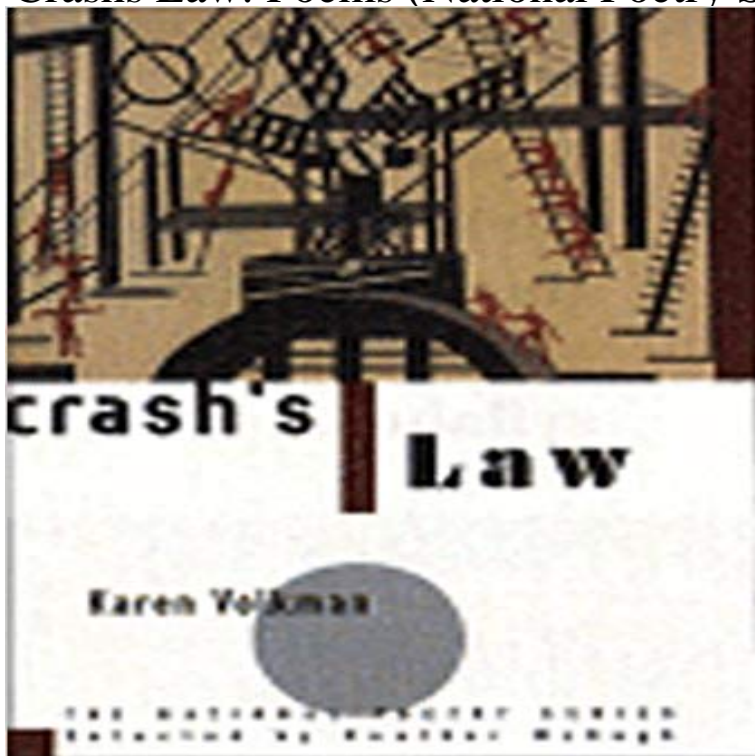


## Crashes Law: Poems (National Poetry Series)
